

AVIATION SECURITY - SYLLABUS

DESCRIPTION

This course focuses on security in aviation including airports, passengers, and cargo as well as in-flight security. It is based on ICAO and European standards and regulations and provides understanding of common rules to protect civil aviation against acts of unlawful interference that jeopardize security.
